

ART Events Website – How to sign up

1 Introduction

This document describes how to sign up for a username at the ART Events Website
<https://events.bellringing.org>

2. The new site is NOT SmART Ringer!



SmART Ringer users, please **read this paragraph carefully!**

- The new ART Events site **is not** SmART Ringer
- Your SmART Ringer login and password **will not work** here
- You need to register for a **separate, new ART Events username** and password, as described in this document

3. Preamble

3.1 In Summer 2019, ART is moving to a new Events Website at <https://events.bellringing.org>. The new site will become the listing and registration hub for all ART events, with a phased transition from the previous SmART Ringer-based system between September and November 2019.

3.2 An event is defined as ‘something run by ART, that people attend’. Events may be free, or paid. Events include courses, workshops, conferences, festivals, and anything else ART thinks up.

3.3 The new Events site contains:

- Information about the types of event on offer (courses for teachers, workshops, other)
- Information about specific events (event listings)
- A registration system allowing signed-up users register (and pay for) places at events
- A ‘My registrations’ page where you can see information about your registrations, download your invoices, tickets, etc.,


4. Introducing tickets for all ART events

4.1 In order to attend an event, you must register, pay (if necessary) and obtain a **ticket**, which must be brought to the event. The system only issues tickets on completion of payment.

4.2 Tutors and workshop leaders will expect to see event tickets when course delegates or workshop participants arrive. For larger events, attendees will be expected to present their ticket at the event registration desk.

5. How do I sign up?

- 5.1 You need a working e-mail address which you can access during the signup process. Have this ready as the signup robot will send you emails during the signup process.
- 5.2 Visit <https://events.bellringing.org>
- 5.3 Find the **Login** panel. Depending on your device, it may be close to the top of the screen (on a mobile device) or to the upper left (tablets and PCs).



Click on the 'Signup...' link as shown. You'll see a **Username Signup** form

- 5.4 Fill out the form.

5.5 If you are **not** (yet) a bell ringer, leave the bell ringer question set to **No** and enter the **county** you live in:

5.6 If you **are** a bell ringer, answer the bell ringer question with a **Yes**, and then tell us your home tower:

... and select your home tower

On the home tower dropdown, find and select your home tower:

If your browser allows it, it's quicker to mouse click in the field and type a few characters...



- 5.8 If your password is too weak, or there are other problems, you'll see an error message at the top of the form:



If this happens, follow the advice in the message to resolve the problem, and then click the blue sign up button again.

- 5.9 The system may take a few seconds to process the form. When this is done you will see the message:


Check your email - confirmation required!

An email with further instructions on how to **confirm your ART Events Username Signup** has been sent to the email address you entered. Please **read this email and follow the instructions** to confirm your signup.

To have the confirmation email sent again, simply try logging in with the username and password you chose at registration.

Remember to check your spam filters if you can't find the email

- 5.10 Now go to your email. After a short while, you should receive an email from **ART Events Signup**. Here's what it looks like in Outlook. In your mail software, it may look different:



To confirm your email address, click on the link in the mail (or cut-and-paste it into your web browser, if you can't click on it directly).


5.11 When you click on the link, it may take a few seconds for things to happen. You should see a web page with this message:


You will also get a second email, confirming that your account has been set up. Here's what it looks like in Outlook. In your mail software, it may look different:



5.12 Now go to the homepage (by clicking as shown in 5.11 above) and find the login panel again. Fill out the fields, using the username and password you chose at signup:




5.13 The first time you log in, the system will show you your user details. This is so you can check that they are all correct, and that you have not mis-typed anything.

5.14 If everything is OK, go to the home page using the blue menu at the top.



As shown above, there are many things you can find and do from this menu.

6. OK, I've signed up! How do I register for the event I'm interested in?

6.1 The first step is to find the event you are interested in. You can do this from the interactive map on the home page:

Click on a location marker for specific event details




...or from the upcoming events list, which shows only the next 10 events:



6.2 Once you have found an event of interest, you will notice 2 registration buttons:



6.3 In each case, clicking on a button will show a registration form. Here's an example of an individual form:

Complete the form, scrolling down if needed to see all the fields. Note that different events may ask different registration questions, and so may not look exactly like the example above.

- 6.4 When you've processed your registration, depending on the payment method available for that event, you may need to make a BACS payment to secure your place. The system will display clear instructions on the screen if you need to do this, and will also send you the same information by email. On screen, it will look something like this:


